## Gamitagama Lake to Old Woman Lake

This is the recommended route to Old Woman Lake. The former route from Mijinemungshing Lake through Mirimoki to Old Woman is impassible due to low water levels. Gamitagama and Old Woman are large lakes; care should be exercised particularly in windy weather.

Access: Gamitagama Road is not marked on Highway 17. Watch for the tower on the nearby hill. The road is east of the Hwy, 10 km north of Gargantua Road; 5 km south of Mijinemungshing Road. Parking is limited at the Gamitagama access point.

Length: 6.3 km from Gamitagama Lake to Old Woman Lake; 7-8 portages (70 m – 880 m)

Time: Allow 2-3 days for a return trip from Gamitagama Lake to Old Woman Lake.

The creek between Pencil and Baillargeon Lakes can usually be paddled, but may have to be portaged in dry conditions.

Portage 7: 800 m; very steep approaching Old Woman Lake.

There are few campsites between Gamitagama and Old Woman Lakes; it is advised to leave sufficient time for the demanding portage 7.
